### **TERM A (12 Week Session: July 6 – September 27)**

## **ASSOCIATE-BACHELOR LEVEL COURSES**

### **BS101 - New Testament Survey**

A study covering the time from the close of the Old Testament through the Revelation. This course is designed to give the student a working knowledge of the background of the New Testament, surveying content as well as the historical setting of each book of the New Testament.

### **BS305 - A Study of I & II Corinthians**

This course will provide a detailed and in-depth exposition of I Corinthians and an overview of II Corinthians. This study will examine the writer, the date and time, and the theme and purpose of each book, as well as its practical application today.

### **BS402 - Major Prophets II: Ezekiel & Daniel** *(No prerequisite)*

A study of the historical and prophetic writings of Ezekiel and Daniel. This study will examine the writer, the theme and purpose of the writings, as well as the methods of ministry.

## **MASTERS LEVEL COURSES**

### **BS505 - A Study of I & II Corinthians**

This course will provide a detailed and in-depth exposition of I Corinthians and an overview of II Corinthians. This study will examine the writer, the date and time, and the theme and purpose of each book, as well as its practical application today.

### **BS512 – A Study of Ezekiel & Daniel**

A study of the historical and prophetic writings of Ezekiel and Daniel. This study will examine the writer, the theme and purpose of the writings, as well as the methods of ministry.

## **DOCTORAL LEVEL COURSES**

### **PH604 - Ecclesiology**

This course studies the theology of the nature, function, and structures of the church. Topics include the biblical foundation and structure of the Church, models of the Church, and the historical development of ecclesial life.

### **TH704 - Historical Theology**

This course examines critically the major theological developments of history, such as the canon of scripture, the doctrine of the Trinity, the person and work of Christ, the doctrine of the church, the doctrine of grace, etc.

## **TERM B (6 Week Session: July 27 – September 6)**

## **ASSOCIATE-BACHELOR LEVEL COURSES**

### **BS106 - A Study of James**

James is one of the most direct and practical writers of the New Testament, providing a valuable understanding of the problems facing many of the early Jewish believers. This detailed and in-depth study will explore the background, purpose, and practical application of this powerful and interesting book, and will leave the student with a renewed faith in our Lord.

### **TH303 - God's Plan for Man**

Anthropology: This course will examine and outline in detail God's plan for man, beginning with the creation, the development and fall of man, as well as God's detailed plan for man's restoration. This course will provide an overview of God's eternal plan for the ages concerning man and the earth.

### **TH329 - The Attributes of God**

Introduction to the doctrine God: This course will examine the nature and existence of God, with particular emphasis on the attributes of God. Upon completion, students should have a deeper understanding of the origin, nature, purpose, and destiny of man.

## ASSOCIATE-BACHELOR LEVEL COURSES
